

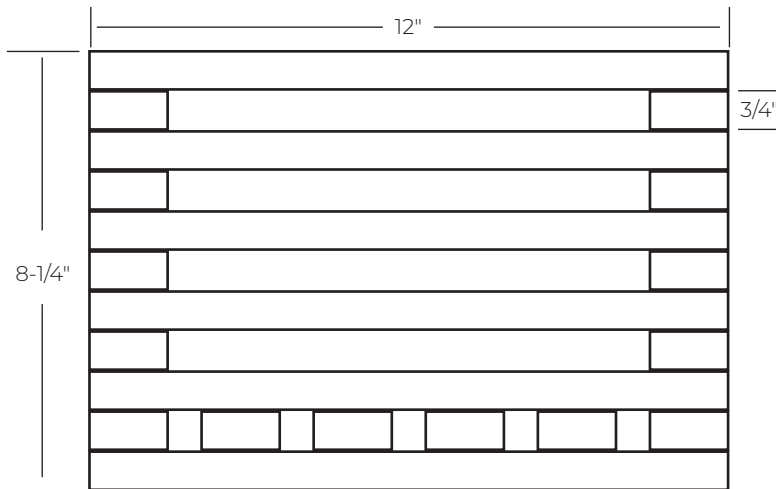

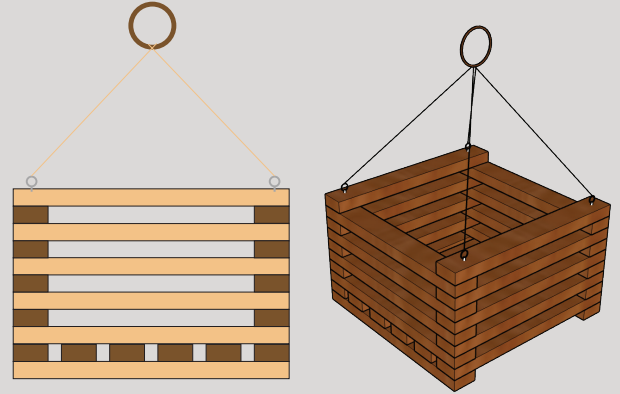
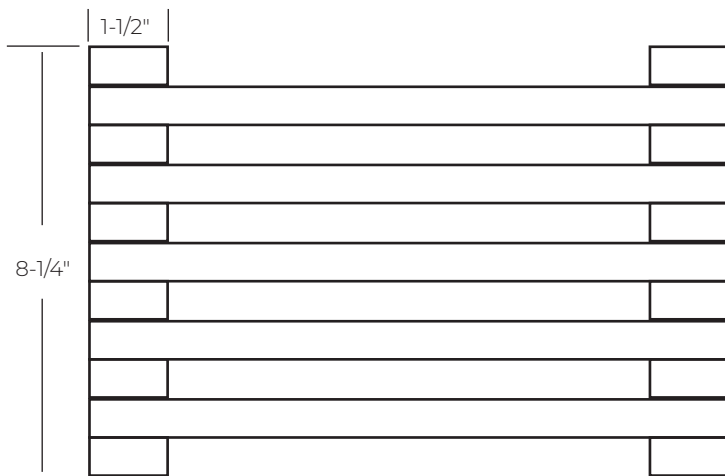
Flower Basket

Tools:

- Miter saw or hand saw
- Pliers
- Drill with 3/32" drill bit, #8 Robertson driver

Materials List:

Material	Quantity
1x2x8 Red or Yellow Cedar	3 Boards
Wood or Metal Ring	1 Piece
#8, 1" Wood Screws	22 Screws
Titebond III Wood Glue	1 Bottle <i>Can be used on additional projects</i>
Eyelet Screws	4 Screws
String or Rope	4 Pieces

Build Instructions:

1. Trim off the rough ends of each 1x2, roughly 1/4"
2. Cut boards into 20, 12" lengths
3. Start at the bottom of the basket, evenly space 6 boards across 2 of the other boards.
4. Drill pilot holes through the overlapping boards and add a small amount of glue between the boards before screwing together. Make sure to offset each screw slightly as to allow screws from the next layer to contact the wood.
5. Start alternating boards in an alternating pattern, think log cabin, glue and drill each overlapping board as you go until you have used all the pieces.
6. Finally drill pilot holes for the eye bolts on the last layer and use the pliers to tighten if necessary.
7. Cut four even lengths of rope and attach to wooden or metal ring.
