

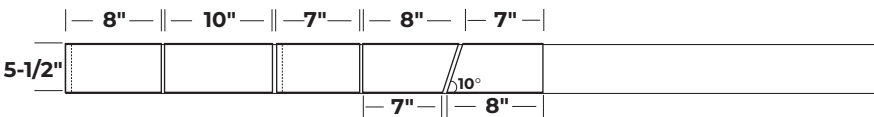

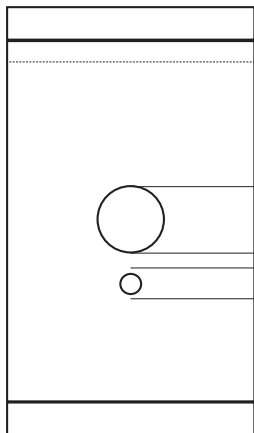
House

Build one of the most classic of woodworking projects with just one board.

Cut Diagram



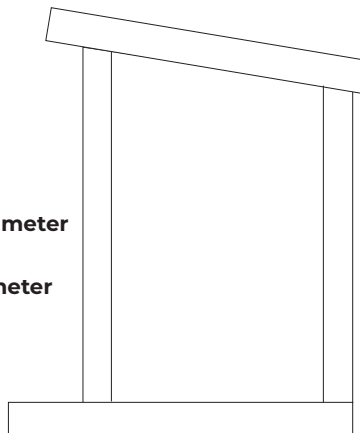
Front View



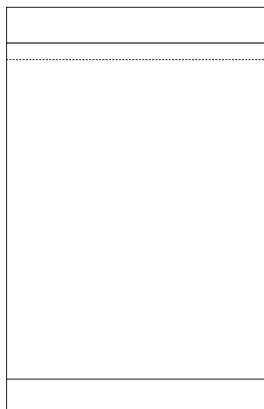
1-1/2" Diameter

Tools:

- Miter saw or hand saw
- #8 Robertson driver
- #8 countersink drill bit
- Staple Gun
- Tape Measure
- 1-1/2" Spade Bit
- 1/4" Drill Bit
- Speed Square
- Pencil

Materials List:

Material	Quantity
1x6x8' Red or Yellow Cedar	1 Boards
1/4" Dowel	1 Dowel
Titebond III Wood Glue	1 Bottle
Finishing Nails	10 Nails
Exterior Finish	Paint or Clear Coat

Build Instructions:

1. Start by trimming off 1/4" of the boards to get a clean end.
2. Using your saw, trim all the boards to length and make all your pieces.
3. On the front and back pieces, you will need to cut a 10° miter along the top of the short edges.
4. For the side pieces you will need to cut 10° from front to back.
5. On the front piece, drill one 1-1/2" hole and one 1/4" hole as shown on the diagram.
6. Assemble the sides using glue and nails to join them together, wipe off excess glue with a wet rag.
7. After the sides are built, attach the roof with glue and nails.
8. Cut off a 2" piece of dowel and glue it into the 1/4" hole.
9. Apply your finish.
