

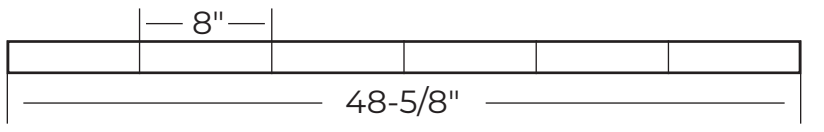


PLAYING CARD

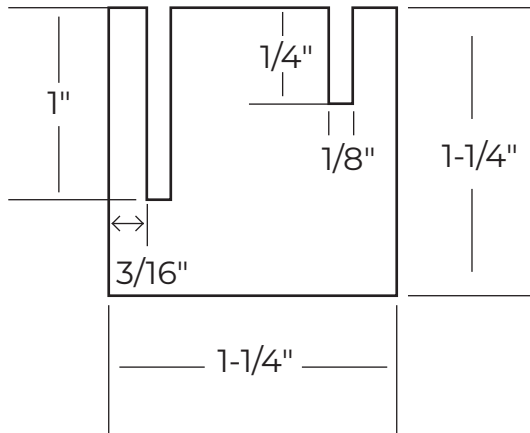
HOLDER

A great simple project you can make to help young kids and people with conditions such as arthritis play card games. Can also be used to hold other items such as photographs or cards.

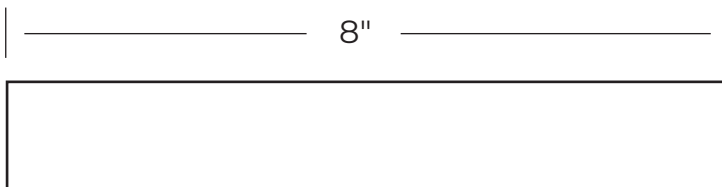
Cut Diagram:

Tools & Materials:

- Table Saw

Materials List:

Material	Quantity
1 - 1/4" Square Maple	48-5/8"
Paint or Stain	As needed

Build Instructions:

1. Start by marking a depth line on each outer face of your square stock. One at 1" and the other at 1/4".
2. With your square stock square with your blade raise it to the height of the line.
3. Move your fence and piece over so that the blade is at least 3/16" in from the edge.
4. Repeat for the line on the other side, raising or lowering the blade to match your line height.
5. Remove your table saw fence and with your miter gauge, cut down into 8" sections. You should have enough to make 6 holders.
6. Finish as desired.
